We seek partners with proven expertise in infrastructure development who share our commitment to community safety and sustainable development.

Who We Are:

Sanjeevani Vikas Evam Jan Kalyan Samiti, also known as Sanjeevani Organisation, is a non-government social organization, registered under the Societies Registration Act 21, 1860. Since our inception in the year 2000, Sanjeevani has been working unremittingly on multiple themes for overall and inclusive development, such as education, health, environment, livelihood, rural development, etc. in rural hilly regions of Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh states in India Sanjeevani is compliant to all the regulations of Government of India and State government such as registration under 12A, and 80G, registered to receive grants under CSR through Form 1 under Ministry of Corporate Affairs, registered under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA). SEWOH Programme Overview:

With support from German Cooperation (BMZ) and CBM, Sanjeevani is building a just society where equity and dignity are accessible to all with 02 other development blocks (Salt & Bhikiyasen) other than the previous. Disability-inclusive development stands at the heart of this initiative. Small and marginal farmers in Almora face steep barriers: poverty, migration, limited landholdings, and lack of access to markets. For persons with disabilities, these challenges are compounded by stigma, inaccessible tools, and exclusion from mainstream programmes. With over 70% of households earning less than €1,000 annually, the need for sustainable, inclusive solutions is urgent.

SEWOH is transforming livelihoods in the hills of Uttarakhand by ensuring that people with and without disabilities participate equally in community-based agriculture.

Based on the principle of "Leave No One Behind", SEWOH empowers 2,500 farmers—including 500 with disabilities—through:

- Community-Based Inclusive Groups (CBIGs).
- Organizations of Persons with Disabilities (OPDs) for collective voice and rights. Through government engagement, rights advocacy, access to assistive devices, BVJF affiliation, and trained leaders, the OPD is empowering persons with disabilities, fostering self-reliant, rights-based communities with sustainable empowerment.
- Training in modern Agri-horticulture, adapted equipment, and high-quality inputs to boost productivity.
- Establishment of two Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) to strengthen market linkages, reduce post-harvest losses, and extend shelf-life of produce.

2. PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The objective is to procure and supply high-quality, weather-resistant Galvanized Steel (GI) Chain Link Fencing to support the SEWOH Programme within the Bhikiyasen and Salt Development Blocks. Chain-link fencing is vital for farmers as it protects crops from stray animals, secures resources, and clearly marks boundaries. It is durable, cost-effective, and helps ensure sustainable cultivation, directly reducing losses and strengthening livelihoods. This project is vital for protecting community assets, supporting agricultural initiatives, and ensuring the safety and well-being of local residents.

Geographic & Demographic Context:

Bhikiyasen and Salt are rural development blocks in Almora District, Uttarakhand, characterized by hilly terrain, smallholder agricultural farms, and limited infrastructure. The region receives significant agricultural income from farming and allied activities, but faces challenges from livestock damage, overgrazing, and property boundary disputes. The population includes small and marginal farmers, landless laborers, and pastoral communities. This fencing project directly addresses key livelihood challenges while promoting sustainable resource management. The region's agricultural potential remains underutilized due to infrastructure limitations, making this fencing investment strategic for community transformation.

Strategic Importance:

Chain-link fencing is foundational to the SEWOH Programme's agricultural development pillar. By securing agricultural land boundaries and enabling farmers to implement improved farming practices, this project catalyzes broader development. Successful fencing implementation demonstrates Sanjeevani's commitment to evidence-based rural development and creates foundation for integrated interventions including improved irrigation, soil management, agricultural extension services, and livestock improvement programs. This tender represents initial phase with potential for expansion based on demonstrated impact and community demand.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

Supply of Galvanized Steel Chain Link Fencing with the following responsibilities:

- **Manufacturing/Sourcing:** Ensure the GI wire is hot-dipped galvanized to prevent corrosion in the local climate
- **Quality Control:** Verify that mesh size and wire gauge are uniform throughout every 15m bundle
- **Delivery:** Transport bundles to designated drop-off points within the Bhikiyasen and Salt Development Blocks
- **Warranty:** Provide 01-year manufacturer warranty on all supplied materials
